

C.V. of Prof. Julio L. Martinez, S.J.

Fr. Julio L. Martinez, S.J. was born in Vigo, Spain in 1964. In April 2012 he was appointed Rector of the Pontifical University Comillas Icai-Icade (Madrid) where he is also Tenured Professor of Moral Theology at the School of Theology. He also teaches regularly at the School of Theology and Philosophy of San Miguel (Argentina) and has given courses and lectures in several European and American countries.

He studied philosophy and theology in Madrid, Cambridge-Boston and Salamanca. Prof. M. Vidal and Prof. D. Hollenbach, S.J. are among his teachers.

He has published and edited several books, of which we mention here a few: *Consenso publico y moral social. Las relaciones entre catolicismo y liberalismo en la obra de J.C. Murray (2002)*; *Comités de bioética (2003)*; *Repensar la dignidad humana (2005)*; *Religion e integracion de los inmigrantes (2006)*; *Ciudadania, migraciones y religion (2007)*; *Libertad religiosa y dignidad humana (2009)*; *Moral social y espiritualidad: una conspiracion necesaria (2011)*. His latest book is *Religion en publico: debate con los liberales (2012)*.

He has turned his attention, in particular, to the importance of religion in public life, the relationship between liberalism and Catholicism and the problem of citizenship in a multicultural and multireligious society.
