The book **“Prinzip Nachhaltigkeit: Ein Entwurf aus theologisch-ethischer Perspektive”** (München-2009, oeKom verlag, third ed. 2013) by **Markus Vogt** is the winner of the third edition of the International “ECONOMY AND SOCIETY” Award, sponsored by the *Centesimus Annus – Pro Pontifice* Foundation.

Started in 2013 by *Centesimus Annus Pro Pontifice* Foundation, the “Economy and Society” Award takes place every two years with the aim to give recognition to works of economic and social content providing outstanding original contribution to the investigation and implementation of Church Social Doctrine; among the required features there must be an indisputable doctrinal soundness and a clear dissemination intent.

Award will take place in the afternoon (5:00 PM) of May 18th 2017 in the *Palazzo della Cancelleria* (Piazza della Cancelleria, Rome) and will be attended by the authors and by Jury's Chairman Card. Reinhard Marx. The ceremony will be chaired by His Eminence the Secretary of State Card. Pietro Parolin. The event will take place on occasion of the International Conference organized by *Centesimus Annus - Pro Pontifice* Foundation on the subject *“Constructive alternatives in an era of global turmoil. Job creation and human integrity in the digital space-incentives for solidarity and civic virtue”* that will be held in the *New Synod Hall* (Vatican City) and in *Palazzo della Cancelleria* (Rome) from May 18th to 20th, 2017.
