The books “CIUDADANIA, MIGRACIONES Y RELIGION”, by Prof. Julio L. Martinez S.J. (Publisher: San Pablo) and “L'ECONOMIA DEL BENE COMUNE” by Prof. Stefano Zamagni (Publisher: Città Nuova) are ex-aequo winners of the first edition of the international award “ECONOMY AND SOCIETY” established by the Foundation *Centesimus Annus – Pro Pontifice*.

This biennial event, launched in 2012, honors works in the field of economics and social sciences published after 1991 (the year the Encyclical *Centesimus Annus* was published) which stand out for their original contribution to in depth study and implementation of the Social Doctrine of the Church, are of proven doctrinal soundness and reach out to a wide audience.
