

Ludwig Ring-Eifel was born in 1960 in Trier, Germany. He earned university degrees in Catholic Theology and in Philosophy.

A journalist since 1987 he first worked for FAZ daily newspaper in Frankfurt. He joined KNA, Germany's official Catholic News-Agency in Bonn, as early as 1990.

Ring-Eifel served as KNA's Rome correspondent from 1996 to 2005. He wrote several books on the papacy and the Vatican, and is author of two documentary films: One about the Second Vatican Council and one about Pope Benedict XVI.

From 2005 to 2022 he was KNA's editor in chief and lived in Bonn and in Berlin.

Since August 2022 he is back in Rome as head of KNA's Vatican office and as their senior correspondent. The Rome office is a joint venture with Austria's Kathpress News-Agency and the Swiss News-Website kath.ch.

Ludwig Ring-Eifel is married to Rita Eifel, who is a teacher, and they have two adult children.
