

Book description. Artificial intelligence permeates many aspects of daily life: researching on internet, applying for a loan, looking for a job, and even getting to know a person through a social platform happens through the action of various artificial intelligence algorithms. These technologies, precisely because they are present only in the background, become almost invisible and unknown in their true nature. Trying to make the action of these tools visible and understandable and asking what to do to manage them and how not to oust humans from decision-making is the goal of this text. In the book, the author addresses the challenge of keeping humanity in control in an age when technology is increasingly becoming a substitute for human decision-making.

The author. Paolo Benanti, born in 1973, is a Third Order Regular franciscan and works in ethics, bioethics and technology ethics. In particular, his studies focus on the management of innovation: Internet and the impact of the Digital Age, biotechnology for human development and biosafety, neurosciences and neurotechnologies. He achieved his licentiate in 2008 and his doctorate in moral theology in 2012 from the Pontifical Gregorian University. The doctoral dissertation entitled "The Cyborg. Body and corporeality in the posthuman era" won the Belarmino-Vedovato Prize. He served on the Artificial Intelligence Task Force to assist the Italian Digital Agency. He is a corresponding member of the Pontifical Academy for Life with a particular mandate for the world of artificial intelligence. In late 2018, he was selected by the Italian Ministry of Economic Development as a member of the group of thirty experts tasked with developing at national level a strategy on artificial intelligence and on shared ledger and blockchain-based technologies.
