

Domenico Fanizza has represented **Italy, the Netherlands, and the United Kingdom at the Executive Directors of the African Development Bank (AFDB)** since November 2022. He was a member of the **International Monetary Fund (IMF) Executive Director Board** during the 2018-22 period representing Italy and four other European countries. Before that, he had already a two-year stint as an Executive Director at the AFDB Board.
